A1 Barrowby Harlaxton Drainage Maintenance

I am writing to inform you that we will carry out essential drainage maintenance work on the A1 Northbound and Southbound between the A52 Barrowby junction and A607 at Harlaxton.

The work will start on the 6th February 2017 and will last for approximately 10 weeks. This is part of our continued investment in the Strategic Road Network in 2017.

Description of works

The work involves repairing and replacing existing drainage, recycling filter drain material and clearing ditches.

Safety is our top priority and to maintain a safe working environment for our workforce and customers, we will need to put traffic management in place in order to carry out the work.

The majority of this work requires a full closure of the A1 between Barrowby and Harlaxton. We will not close the A1 in both directions at the same time.

To minimise disruption to customers, we will carry out the work under night-time full A1 closures from Monday to Friday, 8pm through to 6am. We will also minimise noise disruption to local residents by carrying out noisier tasks during the earlier part of each shift.

Our timetable of work is as follows:

- Monday 6th February through to Friday 3rd March (4 weeks) overnight (8pm to 6am) full closure of the A1 Northbound between A607 Harlaxton and A52 Barrowby.
- Monday 6th March through to Friday 17th March (2 weeks) overnight (8pm to 6am) full closure of the A1 Southbound between A52 Barrowby and A607 Harlaxton

Between Monday 20th March and Friday 14th April (4 weeks), overnight (8pm to 6am) we will have lane closures in both directions on the A1 between A607 Harlaxton and A52 Barrowby. Within this time frame we will also require to close the slip roads at

either Barrowby or Harlaxton junction. Specific dates of these slip road closures will be advertised with signage at the slip roads.

For the full A1 closures there will be a clearly signed diversion route for both local traffic and long distance traffic.

Please note that all planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum
