Rutland recorded **28** confirmed cases of COVID-19 during the latest week (to 28 March) – an increase of **11** cases compared with the previous week. This equates to **70** cases per 100,000 people. The average area in England has recorded a total of **72** coronavirus-related deaths have been registered in Rutland since 19 March.
